BALL - Dahlia 'Mary's Jomanda'

This cultivar is semi-cactus type, dark pink in color, and of size BB. It was propagated, grown, and registered in 2004 by D. Houghton, Ireleth, Askam-in-Furness, Cumbria, UK, and introduced in 2001 by Hall, W.N. & Sons Ltd, Halls of Heddon, Heddon-on-the-Wall, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, Northumberland, UK. It is a sport from 'Jomanda'.



leaves broadly dentate with acute teeth,
3-5 leaflets;
stems green, anthocyanin light dependent
